The use of 4-stroke engine allows an efficient and environment-friendly combustion with reduced exhaust fumes and noise. You can simply fuel them up with normal petrol, without mixing the petrol and oil. 4-stroke engines are also characterized by a quieter, low-vibration engine, which gardeners (and their neighbors) especially appreciate when the tool is used over a longer period of time. The diaphragm carburetor provides a constant flow of fuel and makes sure that the tools even function when used upside down.



Many of the MTD-tools have a special abbreviation: AST. AST stands for „Advanced Starting Technology“, which means that they have an especially efficient and easy to operate starter system. AST supports the start procedure with a spring – all you only have to do is pull the start cable slowly and smoothly. The motor then starts by itself.

Some of the machines also have the „Prime & Pull“-start system: with it, brushcutters are started without using the choke. This saves valuable time while working in the garden.
